Police & Crime

There was a discussion about seeking advice for a Neighbourhood Watch scheme. The local A&S Police Beat Team to be invited to a future meeting on this issue.

Public Forum

A local resident had indicated they wished to speak about parking on Silver Street, but did not attend.

Councillors items

Cllr Preen raised the issue of the change of rules for voting at local elections. There are no local elections in Somerset in 2023, but the new 'Voter ID' rules will apply at any future elections.

District Councillor's report

Cllr Berkshire reported on the progress towards the new unitary Somerset Council.

<u>Finance</u>

The financial report for January was approved

The 2023-24 budget was agreed. This will mean a rise in the precept of 9.9%. Clerk to forward this to Mendip DC finance department.

It was agreed that the following grants be approved, from the 2022-23 budget.

(1) Parish News - £400

(2) Ground Force - £250

(3) Church Parochial Council - £550

There will be a £200 contingency set aside to support the village Coronation celebration.

Kilmersdon Primary School have indicated that they wanted support with £100 with a tree planting scheme. This was agreed.

Councillors confirmed that in future there should be an unallocated grants budget & that organisations be invited to apply.

There is an issue with online access to the bank account & consequently payments. Payments already agreed at previous PC meetings will be paid by cheque.
